Introduction

This policy outlines the guidelines and expectations for the Primary teachers from Swiss International School, Qatar, using the Toddle app as an educational tool. The Toddle app aims to enhance collaboration, communication, and curriculum planning within the IB framework. This policy ensures the effective and responsible use of the Toddle app for educational purposes.

What is Toddle: The Learning Journal?

The Toddle app is intended to support primary teachers in IB schools by facilitating communication, collaboration, and curriculum planning. It provides a platform to streamline the teaching process, share resources, and effectively engage with students and parents.

Aims

Students will develop their understanding of Social Awareness and Social Management and develop the following skills:

- Communicate effectively
- Access, create, and share ideas and their understanding of their learning
- Work collaboratively
- Work in a controlled, safe online setting
- Negotiate and resolve conflict
- Develop leadership skills
- Appreciate diverse perspectives
- Understand relationships

How will Toddle be used at SISQ?

At SISQ, we will use the three main streams of sharing and communicating:

1. Students can share their learning and understanding, hereafter referred to as a Portfolio. The portfolio is accessible by parents and family members and will be used to document learning and assessment tasks and track progress.
2. The link to the class is only shared with trusted family members.
3. Toddle has a component specifically designed to post school-wide or class-wide announcements or send messages to particular families, also giving them the opportunity to contact the teacher directly.
4. Toddle Classroom is used to post learning experiences and assessment tasks. This is also a portal for students to submit their assignments and view the feedback from their teachers.
5. Toddle Calendar is used to schedule Zoom meetings for Online or Blended learning.



Toddle Privacy Principles

An extract from Toddle:

Toddle is completely secure. Data is handled with utmost care:

- Toddle is certified for ISO 27001, 27002, 27017, 27018, COPPA, FERPA and is compliant with [GDPR](#).
- Toddle works with iKeepSafe for all of their certifications and compliance. iKeepSafe is a leading organisation in data privacy for education technology.
- Their servers are based out of Europe and the USA.
- We use Amazon Web Servers for all of our data storage.

Roles and Responsibilities of Stakeholders

Our first and foremost responsibility is to keep our students safe while online and their information private and secure.

Toddle Administrator Responsibilities

- Work collaboratively with the school's Toddle Buddy to roll over the students from one year to another on the platform at the end of the school year and have the platform ready when the new school year starts.
- Homeroom classes are to be set up according to the class list information on ISAMS.
- Set up the Language classes, such as Beginner French or Intermediate Arabic, according to the class sets, within the first two weeks of the new academic year.
- Ensure that new students are added as soon as information is received from the Admissions Team.
- Help teachers and students troubleshoot. If the problem persists, contact the school's Toddle Buddy and see if the problem can be solved from their end.
- Monitor the school's Toddle account to ensure the purchased licenses match the Active Student quota.
- Support Teachers, Students and Home Tutors by using Toddle.
- Ensure the Toddle Policy is available to the school community through the School website.
- Suspend or remove a student account if the student's behaviour is determined to contravene the School's Student Code of Conduct (Policy).

Staff Responsibilities

- The Toddle app is designed to assist teachers in planning and organising their curriculum according to the IB framework.
- Teachers can upload and share resources, lesson plans, assessments, and other relevant materials with colleagues and parents.
- All shared content should align with the school's educational goals and values.
- All planning: Unit planners and Weekly planning should be done on Toddle
- All assessment tasks should be done on Toddle.
- Ensure that all essential PYP elements are evidenced: ATL, Learner Profile
- Teachers should use the Toddle app to communicate with colleagues, parents, and students in a professional and respectful manner.
- Collaborative features like discussion boards and shared planning spaces should be



utilised to cultivate teamwork and idea-sharing.

- Teachers can use the Toddle app to engage students in learning activities, share assignments, and provide timely feedback.
- Students' privacy and data protection should be maintained while using the app. Avoid sharing sensitive information.
- Ensure that learners have ongoing discussions on Digital Citizenship - responsible online behaviour and respectful commenting when appropriate.
- Teachers provide ongoing feedback to learners.
- Teachers ensure that they are evidencing each student's learning.
- Notify the Toddle Administrator if a learner needs to be added or removed from your class (rvtadica@sisq.qa, amutwiri@sisq.qa)
- Ensure that learners have a school-approved Profile photo, which will be printed on the front cover of the mid-year and end-of-year reports.
- The school administration may monitor app usage to ensure compliance with this policy and to provide support where needed.
- Training sessions will be conducted to help teachers effectively use the app's features and functionalities.

Learner Responsibilities

- Use Toddle for educational purposes only. This is a digital learning portfolio, so items that show learning achievements and progress are posted on Toddle.
- Being a Good Digital Citizen.
- Ensure work is submitted in accordance with the teachers' requests and timelines.
- Ensure that items are tagged according to the teacher's instructions.
- Only post materials and comments in alignment with the School's Student Code of Conduct. Ensure that all communication is courteous, considerate and respectful.
- Do not share passwords or any private information.
- Learners will sign into Toddle using their own account and not the account of other learners.
- Learners will not allow other learners to use their Toddle account.

Parent Responsibilities

- The Toddle app facilitates parent-teacher communication by allowing teachers to share student progress, updates, and important information.
- Parents should be encouraged to actively participate in their child's learning journey through the app.
- Take note of all Home-School Communication sent on Toddle.
- Ensure that learners understand their responsibilities when using Toddle. Learners need to understand the difference between appropriate and inappropriate use.
- All communication through Toddle must be courteous, considerate and respectful.
- Parents will only share their own child's work/photos outside of Toddle.

Only posts containing learning, assessment or tracking progress should be added to each student's Portfolio.
